In 2021, the Ardenza Foundation, directed by Ms Daniela DIKOVA, Head of the Department of Chamber Music and Traditional Music at the Sofia Academy of Arts, asked Ms Milena JELIAZKOVA, a teacher at the IIMM, to lead a master-class in Rila in Bulgaria, in «Bulgarian traditional songs» for French, Italian and Belgian students, as well as IIMM students. Since August 2022, this partnership has materialised itself in the form of the said master-class, which is repeated annually and attracts a growing number of participants each year. From 28 students in 2022 to 35 students in 2023, this course is attracting a great deal of interest from people wishing to become more professional and improve their skills and knowledge in the field.

This unique experience allowed them to discover new repertoires, and above all to experience total immersion in a place where the musical and vocal heritage is still alive. Throughout the week, the students sang in musical evenings and in the presence of local residents. Musical encounters also took place in the town of Smotchevo. This was an opportunity for the participants to explore the specific characteristics of this region of Bulgaria, in particular secular and sacred polyphony. In turn, local teachers were invited:

- Ms Fiki MILOVSKA, a traditional dancer from the Pirin folk region
- Mr Ivica ANTEV, a traditional dancer from Serbia and Macedonia
